We are doing well physically. Loveta has had some difficulties this past week but is feeling better today. I have felt very close to her for many years, ever since I went to live with her and Uncle Bob (who died in 1976) after my dad died in 1944. I lived with them in 1945-47 in Midland, TX. When I lived with them they had only one son (1 yr older than me) but had two more fine sons later. All three and their families were able to be together this week.

This New Year is getting off to a good start with continuous studies & Vidyo Bible classes. The weather today is dreadful and yet I have been able to study in the book of Hebrews and Revelation with different students outside the USA.. How blessed we are to be living in these times. In addition to daily Bible classes I am able to be teaching Daniel on Sunday mornings and often preach in Estonia and Iceland on Sunday.

Later, his brother, **Eric**, (mid-20's) began to study and this past week he also became your brother. Who knows how many souls will be influenced to meet you in heaven because of this family. Pray for them as they continue to grow in the Lord.

The severe fatigue that has plagued me over the past 18 months has just about disappeared. Some fatigue pops up every once in a while but it is not debilitating like it was... for which I am so very grateful. This has come about just in time for me to be able to shovel
